NOTICE is hereby given that the Annual Meeting of Dartmouth Fire District No. 1 will be held at the Engine House, 10 Bridge Street, Dartmouth, Massachusetts on Wednesday May 8, 2013, at 6:30 P.M.. Then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the District will vote to compensate firefighter recruits at the rate of \$17.00 per hour, firefighter Step 1 at the rate of \$22.00 per hour, firefighter Step 2 at the rate of \$20.00 per hour, lieutenants at the rate of \$24.00 per hour, house captains at the rate of \$21.00 per hour and line captains at the rate of \$26.00 per hour and dispatchers at the rate of \$18.00 per hour for toned incidents and to further compensate all district personnel for all other duties at the rate of \$18.00 per hour.
